2. Teams & Divisions for 2011 Season
  - Men's – 36 Teams, 6 Divisions of 6, 2 move up/down at end of each session
  - 4 New teams for 2013
  - Playoffs will be the same as last year
  - Point structure for Men's A Division will be changed
  
  - Women's – 9 Teams – Play everyone twice
  - Playoffs – TBD by end of 1<sup>st</sup> Session.
  
3. Start of the season
  - Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup> (Depending on fields/weather) Games will be cancelled from this day forward and moved to Sunday's or the end of session 1.
  
4. Schedule (Brad & Chris)
  - Schedule will be posted for only the 1<sup>st</sup> Session. 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> will be posted near the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> Session.
  - If your dates haven't been turned in yet it is too late for the 1<sup>st</sup> session.
  
5. Fees
