Presidents Report:

- Murray reported that we have a few new teams in the league this year. General rules for the league are attached in the handout for the teams, mentioned there should be some patience with the new teams this year, however there will be no tolerance for ref abuse.
- A motion was passed to purchase jackets for the referees
- Port-a-pottie was discussed. James is to call Loraas about the Port-a-pottie as well as call A-1 Rentals to see if they rent and costs, etc.
- Murray will check with Dave on the scorecards
- Joanne/Kyle to make sure that rosters and code of conduct are at field for all teams
- Sue is to get minutes done

Treasurer's Report:

- Bank of Montreal money should be transferred by the end of the week
- Everything else is paid up to date

Schedule, Format and Fields:

- Murray confirmed that the 18 game format for men's and women's schedule will go to October 5th. Rainouts will be Sunday's in the day only. Playoff's men's will be 7-6 game, top 2 get bye, 2-6 playoff. Women's will be a 6-4 split.
- Practice times – the fields will be available for booking after the meeting – just need to e-mail the league.
- If a team wants to re-schedule the only time made available will be Sunday's in the day until mid August and then only Saturdays after that. Teams wanting to change will have to arrange with the other team and the officials through Nancy. As well they will need to provide officials for the affected game unless Nancy arranges otherwise.
- Murray confirmed the schedule should be done by the end of the week.

Fees:

- Discussed that with the 10th team for Women being added, their fees will now be the same as the Men's. Fees will be \$1,450 for existing teams and \$1,550 for new teams.
- Fees are due May 3rd

Pre-Season & Labour Day:

- Pre-season tournament draft will be held on Friday, May 2nd at the Press Box

Women's Pre-season Schedule:

- Schedule is in handout. Games are Tuesday and Thursday nights

Referees:

- Nancy confirmed the Officials Clinic will be on May 10th at Riffel. Level 1 will be from 9-12pm and Level 2 from 1-4pm.
- Nancy motioned to carry the purchase of jackets for referees, Joanne 2nd – motion carried. Referees that do a minimum of 10 games will get a coat with the RTFI logo on it supplied by the league.

Provincials:

- Are in Saskatoon this year – when??? Not sure yet.

Other Business:

- Discussed the possibility of a min. number of games requirement to be eligible to play in playoffs. Just not sure how it can be regulated.
- Also discussed the # of people that can be rostered on a team so that in case of injuries teams would still have enough for provincials. Decided they were find for now.
